Lip Filler Migration

Common Causes, Signs, and How It's Fixed



1. WHAT IT IS

Migrated lip filler is filler that has moved beyond the natural lip border, often creating puffiness, blurring, or fullness outside the intended lip shape.



2. COMMON CAUSES

- Too much filler too quickly
- Frequent overfilling over time
- Poor placement or technique
- Treating lips that already contain migrated filler
- Individual anatomy and tissue support



3. COMMON SIGNS

- Blurred lip border
- Fullness above the upper lip
- Puffy or shelf-like upper lip
- Asymmetry or uneven shape
- Lips that look heavier rather than more defined



4. HOW IT'S FIXED

- 1 Assessment of your lips and existing filler
- 2 Strategic dissolving when needed
- 3 Time for swelling to settle and tissue to reset
- 4 Careful refill only if appropriate, using a conservative plan



5. CAN IT BE PREVENTED?

- Choose an experienced injector
- Use a conservative treatment plan
- Avoid adding more filler before reassessment
- Let your provider evaluate old filler first

MIGRATED / OVERFILLED LOOK



Filler extends beyond the natural lip border, creating puffiness and a less defined shape.



CORRECTED, BALANCED RESULT



A balanced lip with a clean border and natural definition.



IMPORTANT NOTE

Not every overfilled-looking lip is true migration. A qualified assessment helps determine whether dissolving, waiting, or careful reshaping is the best next step.
